

There was a mixed reception to the rear engined Bristol VRT when it was introduced. Midland Scottish purchased a number of the early builds but found them troublesome. After returning these buses to Bristol for improvements they were still unhappy with them and eventually did a swap with Eastern National for Lodekka's.

Once in service at their new home in Essex they became reliable and popular. At the time of the swap many were to retain their blue and cream colours making them an attractive addition to the Eastern National fleet, some being garaged at Wood Green for the London services.

Registration number SMS 32H, fleet number SD 3006. Operates route 11 to Chelmsford.





Only a few of London's Utility buses lasted long enough to be painted into post war livery and the last of the Guy Arab II's worked routes from Enfield and Upton Park garages. Our Guy G 142 registered GYE 86 operated from Enfield garage and is working route 121 to Chingford.

The uniqueness of these Guy's make them an important addition to any London Bus collection.
